Due to the stabilization of the epidemic situation in Poland and neighbouring countries, as well as taking into account the recommendations provided by the European Commission, please be informed that the Polish Government made a decision to lift temporary border controls at Poland's internal borders introduced according to Article 25(1) and Article 28(1) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/399 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on a Union Code on the rules governing the movement of persons across borders (Schengen Borders Code). The process will take place on 12th June 2020 (9 a.m) at the internal border with the Republic of Lithuania and on 13th June 2020 at sections of the Polish border with the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, the Federal Republic of Germany, as well as at sea and air border crossing points.

Please find attached the letter of Mr Bartosz Grodecki, the Undersecretary of State at the Ministry of Interior and Administration of the Republic of Poland.

w związku z ustabilizowaniem się sytuacji epidemicznej na terytorium Rzeczypospolitej Polskiej oraz w państwach sąsiadujących, a także uwzględniając zalecenia Komisji Europejskiej w zakresie przywracania swobody przemieszczania się w ramach Unii Europejskiej uprzejmie informuję, że kontrole graniczne, które były prowadzone zgodnie z art. 25 ust. 1 i 28 ust. 1 rozporządzenia Parlamentu Europejskiego i Rady (UE) 2016/399 z dnia 9 marca 2016 r. w sprawie unijnego kodeksu zasad regulujących przepływ osób przez granicę (kodeks graniczny Schengen) (Dz. Urz. UE. L 77 z 23.3.2016, s. 1 z późn. zm.), na odcinkach granicy państwowej Rzeczypospolitej Polskiej z:

- Republiką Litewską zostały zakończone z dniem 12 czerwca 2020 r. (godz. 9:00);
- Republiką Czeską, Republiką Słowacką, Republiką Federalną Niemiec oraz w morskich i lotniczych przejściach granicznych zostaną zakończone z dniem 13 czerwca 2020 r.

Powyższa decyzja umożliwi osobom swobodne przekraczanie granicy wewnętrznych bez konieczności poddawania się kontroli granicznej oraz zalnicjuje proces etapowego przywracania swobodnego przemieszczania się w ramach Unii Europejskiej.

Due to the stabilisation of the epidemiological situation on the territory of the Republic of Poland and in the neighbouring states, as well as taking account of the European Commission's recommendations regarding the reintroduction of the freedom of movement within the European Union, I kindly inform you that border controls that were introduced according to the art. 25.1 and 28.1 of the regulation (EU) 2016/399 of 9 March 2016 on a Union Code on the rules governing the movement of persons across borders (Schengen Borders Code) (Official Journal of the European Union, L 77, 23 March 2016), at the national border of the Republic of Poland, section of border with:

- The Republic of Lithuania were ceased on 12 June 2020 (9:00 am);
- The Czech Republic, Slovak Republic, Federal Republic of Germany as well as sea and air borders will cease on 13 June 2020.

The above decision will allow for crossing the border freely, without the need to undergo border control and will initiate the staged process of reintroducing free movement within the European Union.
