1. On 21 April 2021, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 8176/21 + ADD 1 + ADD 2) in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision No 1999/468/EC¹, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC², laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
2. The Working Party of Agricultural Counsellors considered, through an informal written consultation³, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
