## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the effective coordination of economic policies and on multilateral budgetary surveillance and repealing Council Regulation (EC) No 1466/97 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 26 April 2023 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 121(6) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Central Bank</u> delivered its opinion on 5 July 2023<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 21 September 2023<sup>3</sup>.
- 4. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 10 October 2023<sup>4</sup>.
- 5. On 23 April 2024 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>5</sup>.

- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 51/24, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Belgium</u> abstaining.
- 7. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 8. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

  After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
