## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

To:	Permanent Representatives Committee/Council
Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing a common procedure for international protection in the Union and repealing Directive 2013/32/EU (first reading)  - Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 13 July 2016 the Commission submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 78(2), point (d) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. On 23 September 2020 the Commission submitted an amended proposal<sup>2</sup>, based on Article 78(2), point (d) and Article 79(2), point (c) TFEU, to the Council.
- 3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinions on 14 December 2016<sup>3</sup> and on 25 February 20214.
- The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinions on 8 February 2017<sup>5</sup> and on 19 March 4 2021<sup>6</sup>.

- 5. On 10 April 2024 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal<sup>7</sup>. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u><sup>8 9</sup> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 16/24, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Hungary</u> and <u>Poland</u> voting against and the <u>Czech Republic</u>, <u>Malta</u> and <u>Slovakia</u> abstaining.
- 7. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 8. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
