Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing a return border procedure, and amending Regulation (EU) 2021/1148 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 13 July 2016 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 78(2), point (d) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. On 23 September 2020 the <u>Commission</u> submitted an amended proposal², based on Article 78(2), point (d) and Article 79(2), point (c) TFEU, to the Council.
- 3. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinions on 14 December 2016³ and on 25 February 2021⁴.
- 4. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinions on 8 February 2017⁵ and on 19 March 2021⁶.

- 5. On 10 April 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal⁷. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
- 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council⁸ approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 17/24, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with Hungary and Poland voting against and Czech Republic and Slovakia abstaining.
- 7. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum to this note.
- 8. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.

In accordance with Articles 1 and 2 of Protocol No 22 on the position of Denmark, annexed to the TEU and to the TFEU, Denmark is not taking part in the adoption of this Regulation and is not bound by it or subject to its application. Given that this Regulation builds upon the Schengen acquis, Denmark shall, in accordance with Article 4 of that Protocol, decide within a period of six months after the Council has decided on this Regulation whether it will implement it in its national law.
