WRITTEN QUESTIONS FROM HUNGARY ON THE
THE REVISION OF THE BREAKFAST DIRECTIVES - AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

We are grateful for the proposal that we have been waiting for. We thank the possibility for clarifying questions as well. We understand that proposals will be required at a later stage. Questions to the Commission for the VTC on 16 May are the following.

Directive 2001/110/EC

- Why the Commission does not include any further details to the listing of countries of origin in relation to honey blends? These further details could include placement of the countries' list, possibilities of countries' denominations, requirement for specific order of countries not to be misleading, etc.
- How the Commission sees the relationship between the exception of packages smaller than 25g and Art 16 (2) of Regulation 1169/2011/EU?

Directive 2001/112/EC

- In Annex 1a, why Council Directive 98/83/EC is not replaced by Directive 2020/2184?
- In Annex 1b, the „no added sugar” claim is in contradiction with Regulation 1924/2006/EC.

Directive 2001/113/EC

- As Art 2(4) is deleted, the reference to that paragraph in Art 2(5) should be amended as well.
- As regards the indication of sulphur-dioxide described in Art 2(6), Art 21 of Regulation 1169/2011/EU does not require its labelling on its own?
