- 1. On 17 May 2018 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Article 172 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 17 October 2018².

- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 6 February 2019³.
- 4. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 13 February 2019⁴.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirmed on 17 June 2020 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators.
- 6. On 14 July 2020 the <u>European Parliament's Committee on Transport and Tourism (TRAN)</u> confirmed the provisional agreement, and its chair subsequently sent a letter to the chair of Coreper declaring that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic review) without amendments.
- 7. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to suggest that the <u>Council</u> adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 10537/20, and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 10537/20 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
