- 1. On 13 June 2018 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Articles 42, 43(2), 91(1), 100(2), 173(3), 175, 188, 192(2), 194(2), 195(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 9 October 2018<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 12 December 2018<sup>3</sup>.
- The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 4 April 2019<sup>4</sup>. 4.

- 5. On 22 February 2021 the <u>European Parliament's Committee Fisheries (PECH)</u> confirmed the provisional agreement and its chair sent a letter on 25 February 2021 to the chair of Coreper declaring that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic review) without amendments.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirmed on 3 March 2021 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators.
- 7. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to suggest that the Council:
  - adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 6975/21 + REV 1 (lt), and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 6975/21 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with <a href="Sweden">Sweden</a> voting against and <a href="Lithuania">Lithuania</a> abstaining;
  - approve the Joint Statement by the <u>Council</u> and the <u>Commission</u> and the Joint Statement by the <u>European Parliament</u>, the <u>Council</u> and the <u>Commission</u> as set out in Addendum 1 to this note.
- 8. The Joint Statement by the <u>Council</u> and the <u>Commission</u> and the Joint Statement by the <u>European Parliament</u>, the <u>Council</u> and the <u>Commission</u> for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum 1 to this note. The statements by <u>Lithuania</u>, <u>Sweden</u> and by the Commission for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum 2.
