Statement by the Italy

"While in a spirit of compromise Italy supports the Presidency's compromise text as a basis for the Council's mandate, we strongly believe that important aspects could be further improved in the course of negotiations, as follows.

• It should be clearly established in the binding part of the proposal that Member States will be duly consulted on the adoption of guidance regarding the criteria for determining the existence of a distortion caused by a foreign subsidy on the internal market, the application of the balancing test, and the application of the Commission's power to request prior ad hoc notifications.

• The list of redressive measures in Article 6(3) should be exhaustive, in order to ensure legal certainty.

• The delegated powers to the Commission under Articles 44, 45, and 45a of the Proposal concern essential elements, namely the thresholds for notification, and should therefore be deleted.

• Finally, the establishment of a database accessible to Member States and including all decisions adopted under the Proposal is essential for the correct functioning of public procurement and should be included in a specific article of the Regulation.

We are confident that such requests will be taken in due and serious account in the course of future negotiations."

The expression of the Union position in a body set up by an agreement is an act of external representation of the Union which, in accordance with Article 17(1) TEU, is the institutional prerogative of the Commission.

The Commission reserves all its rights in this regard."

Statement by Hungary

"Hungary would like to state that Joint Communication of the European Commission and the High Representative on the third Gender Action Plan (GAP) of 25 November 2020 in the document officialy named EU Gender Action Plan (GAP) III An Ambitious Agenda For Gender Equality And Women's Empowerment In EU External Action, was adopted by the European Commission and welcomed through Presidency Conclusions by 24 Member States. Hungary recognizes and promotes equality between men and women in accordance with the Fundamental Law of Hungary, and the primary law, principles and values of the European Union, as well as commitments and principles stemming from the international law. In line with these and its national legislation, Hungary interprets the term of 'gender' as reference to 'sex'."

Statement by Poland

"Equality between women and men is enshrined in the treaties of the European Union as a fundamental right. Poland ensures equality between women and men within the framework of the Polish national legal system in accordance with internationally biding human rights instruments and within the framework of fundamental values and principles of the European Union. For these reasons, in place where the text refers to the term "gender equality" Poland will interpret it as an equality between women and men, according to Article 8 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the EU."
