Subject:	Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers following an application from Greece (EGF/2021/008 EL/Attica electrical equipment manufacturing)

1. On 30 May 2022, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF), accompanied by the corresponding proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 13/2022¹.
2. The proposal aims to mobilise a total amount of EUR 1.5 million under the EGF to meet an application from Greece to deploy the Fund, following layoffs in six enterprises operating in the electrical equipment manufacturing sector in the region of Attica, in order to provide assistance for re-integrating the 206 targeted beneficiaries concerned into the labour market, in line with Regulation (EU) 2021/691².
