Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the reduction of methane emissions in the energy sector and amending Regulation (EU) 2019/942 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 15 December 2021, the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 194(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 19 May 2022<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 12 October 2022<sup>3</sup>.

- 4. On 10 April 2024, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal<sup>4</sup>. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
- The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 86/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Hungary</u> voting against.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
