Delegations will find attached a statement by the German delegation on abovementioned subject.

STATEMENT BY GERMANY

Germany supports the intention to have a Joint Declaration with Egypt on energy and climate, and a trilateral MoU with Egypt and Israel on LNG but regrets that the process has not allowed for substantial and proper inclusion of the Council in the negotiations, emphasizing that the Council working group MaMa is not an energy-political format where such MoUs and Joint Declarations should be solely discussed.

Both the MoU and the Joint Declaration concern member states' international energy-political interests, which is why Germany wishes to urge the Commission to improve on its coordination with member states in such matters.
