In accordance with Article 1 of Protocol (No 22) on the position of Denmark, annexed to the Treaty on European Union and the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, Denmark does not take part in the adoption by the Council of measures proposed pursuant to Title V of Part Three of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.

Denmark therefore did not take part in the Council’s adoption of the above implementing decision, which is not binding upon or applicable in Denmark (see Article 2 of the Protocol).

The implementing decision constitutes a development of the Schengen acquis. In accordance with Article 4 of the Protocol, Denmark has to decide, within a period of six months after the Council has decided on a proposal to build upon the Schengen acquis covered by Title V of Part Three of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, whether it will implement the measure in its national law. If Denmark decides to do so, that decision will create an obligation under international law between Denmark and the other Member States bound by the measure.

On that basis, Denmark hereby gives notice that it has decided to implement the above implementing decision in Danish law in accordance with Article 4 of Protocol (No 22).
