On Wednesday 30th September, we will hold an informal videoconference of the members of the Ad-hoc Working Party on NDICI. The meeting will take place from 15h00 to 16h30. It will be hosted by the Council using the Council videoconference platform PEXIP. The delegations will shortly receive relevant practical information and login details to access the meeting. Delegates are kindly invited to test their connection prior to the meeting.

At the meeting, we propose the following sequence of issues:

- 1. Adoption of the agenda (15h00)**
- 2. Preparation of political trilogue on 2 October 2020 (15h05 – 16h25)**

On the basis of the circulated draft agenda for the fifth political trilogue on NDICI on 2 October as well as explanations given by the Presidency in preceding meetings, MS will be invited to confirm their agreement to the proposed outcomes of the different elements of the agenda (endorsement of text provisionally agreed at technical level, provisions to be discussed at political level and orientation debate on the main outstanding issues).

Specifically with regard to the finalisation of Cluster IV (EFSD+), Member States will be invited to indicate their support to the negotiation strategy as put forward by the Presidency in the last meetings, including red lines and elements for possible compromise.
