We are delighted to invite you to the sixth meeting of the Working Party on Public Health under the Czech Presidency of the Council of the European Union. It will be held in physical format starting from 10:00 to 13:00 and continuing from 14:30 till 18:30. The agenda has been circulated and is available in Delegates Portal as document CM 4020/22.

I. Continuation in the first reading of the proposal for the EHDS regulation

We will continue with the examination of the proposal for the EHDS regulation, by reading of individual articles of Chapter IV of the proposal with the aim to complete its first reading (i.e. until Article 58).

In order to facilitate the discussion, the Presidency would like to provide delegations with the opportunity to share their questions or indicate problematic provisions related to the above-mentioned articles in advance with the Presidency, if they wish so. The Presidency will make these questions available to the Commission, so they can better prepare for the discussion and provide delegations with comprehensive answers during the meeting. The possibility of delegations to raise any question or issue (whether sent to the Presidency in advance or not) during the meeting is of course not affected by this exercise.

Jan Janský



Jan Janský (1873-1921) was a famous Czech neurologist, psychiatrist and a professor, who classified blood into four types known and used today: A, B, AB and 0. His discovery came as a by-product of a psychiatric research where he searched for a connection between blood types and mental illnesses. Nowadays, the Red Cross awards a commemorative Janský plaque to Czech and Slovak blood donors annually.
