

### **Key features of RWE**

- Independent bodies (8): EU (6), non-EU (2)
- Mandated to
  - (1) Scrutinise Impact Assessments
  - (2) Advise Governments on Better Regulation


### **Objectives of RWE**

- Exchange experiences & best practise
- Represent interests of independent scrutiny and advisory bodies at European and international level

### Better Regulation at EU-level: RegWatchEurope's perspective


- > Better Regulation has made good progress at EU level.
- > Key success factor for improvement of Commission's impact assessments: RSB
- > But: Complaints about red tape persist and better regulation through the legislative cycle still suffers from some weaknesses.
- > RegWatchEurope's experience: Independent advice and scrutiny encourages governments to improve their better regulation approach as a whole.
- ➤ RegWatchEurope has explored how to further strengthen independent advice and scrutiny at EU level particularly with regard to the mandate of the RSB.








#### **Current Situation:**



- No own better regulation approach
- Implementation of IIA\*: Parliament assessed impacts of some significant amendments
- No oversight body



- No own better regulation approach
- Implementation of IIA\*: still pending
- No oversight body

### RWE Recommendations for Parliament & Council:



- Better Regulation Approaches forming a level-playing field
- Common methodology
- Impact assessments for all significant amendments (principle of responsibility)
- Independent oversight of quality of impact assessments
