Dear colleagues,

we would like to invite you to attend the meeting of the Working Party on Consumer Protection and Information, which will be dedicated to the proposal on financial services contracts concluded at a distance and repealing Directive 2002/65/EC (DMFS). The meeting will take place on 16 September 2022 in a physical format.

In preparation for this meeting a questionnaire has been sent, as well as the three-column table for any comments and drafting suggestions. The questionnaire has focused on the matter of application of the DMFS, information requirements, the withdrawal button, online fairness and what other provisions, from either the CRD or the "old" DMFSD, should be considered for the proposal. The Working Party will focus on the evaluation of the responses and some further discussion on these topics. Some points in particular require debate, such as the characteristics of the withdrawal button feature, how layering of information should be done, and the suggested additions to the proposal from the CRD and "old" DMFSD.

Based on the above-mentioned written contributions, as well as the discussion on those topics expected at this Working Party, the Presidency will begin preparing the first re-draft of the proposal.

The Presidency would like to thank delegations for their valuable comments and insights. We are looking forward to seeing you on 16 September.
