191	<p>7. As of 1 January 2031, Article 15 shall apply also to tariffs for access to hydrogen networks. Articles 16 and 17 shall not apply. No tariffs shall be charged pursuant to Article 15 for access to hydrogen networks at interconnection points between Member States. Where a Member State decides to apply regulated third party access to hydrogen networks in accordance with Article 31 of [recast Gas Directive] before 1 January 2031, paragraph 1 of Article 15 shall be applicable to access tariff to hydrogen networks in that Member State.</p>	<p>7.
