WORKING PARTY ON HORIZONTAL AGRICULTURAL QUESTIONS - CAP REFORM

The Presidency would like to pursue the technical examination of the proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing rules on support for strategic plans to be drawn up by Member States under the Common agricultural policy (CAP Strategic Plans) and financed by the European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF) and by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1305/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Regulation (EU) No 1307/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council (hereinafter "**CAP Strategic Plans Regulation**").

The meeting will take place on 21 November in room LEX 1 of the LEX building and start at 10.00.

The Presidency will continue the discussion on the New Delivery Model presenting its drafting suggestions on **Articles 121 and 121a** (WK 12960/2019).

Delegations will then have the opportunity to express their views on whether they consider the drafting suggestions acceptable in one table round for the two Articles.

The Commission will be invited to provide technical clarifications on those Articles and reply to the delegations' questions as appropriate.

The Presidency has also published drafting suggestions on Articles 74 and 75 (to align them with the Common Provisions Regulation) and on Articles 68, 83, 98, 114, Annex II and Annex XII (technical clarifications - WK 13003/2019 REV1).

Delegations will have the opportunity to ask questions, if needed.
