Dear colleagues,

The Presidency would like to invite you to our twelfth meeting of the Working Party on Competitiveness and Growth for Internal Market (G.01 E), which will take place on 14 November 2022 in a **physical format** (1+1). We are planning a full-day meeting, starting at 9:30.

The morning session will be dedicated to the proposal on the **Single Market Emergency Instrument Regulation (SMEI)**. The Commission will present the notification procedure set in the proposal and its interplay with other notifications procedures under different legislative acts, with the exchange of views to follow. In the second part of the morning session, the Commission will have the opportunity to react and elaborate on the initial written comments of Member States. Lastly, the Member States will have the chance to continue the discussion on the Impact Assessment should they wish to.

During the afternoon session, we will continue examining the proposal for the **Ecodesign Regulation**, specifically the remaining **Chapters X** on Incentives (Articles 57 and 58) and **XIII** on Delegated powers and committee procedure (Articles 66 and 67), together with corresponding recitals.

With that, we should finish the first reading of the proposal. In line with the indicative planning already distributed previously, we would like to ask you for your **written comments on Chapters X to XIV** (and respective recitals, definitions and annex) and to submit them to us no later than by **18 November**.

We thank you for your outstanding cooperation and we look forward to seeing you on 14 November!
