WP on Competitiveness and Growth (Internal Market)

Tuesday, 25 November 2025, 10:00

Dear colleagues,

The Working Party on Competitiveness and Growth (Internal Market) will meet on **25 November 2025**. We will dedicate this full day to a range of topics, covering responsible business conduct, the Single Market Strategy and online platforms.

In the **morning session**, the Commission will first present a state of play on the Forced Labour Regulation and other policy developments in the area of responsible business conduct. Next, the Commission will give a presentation on the “unpacking” work of the Terrible Ten barriers identified in the Single Market Strategy, which will also serve as basis for the discussions at the Competitiveness Council on 8 December. The presentation will explain this new analytical framework and will be followed by an exchange of views. We have prepared a discussion note with questions to consider.

In the **afternoon session**, the Commission will present the evaluation of the Digital Services Act, currently scheduled for adoption on 19 November. Colleagues in the Working Party on Telecommunications and Information Society will hear the same presentation in their morning session the same day.

We look forward to seeing you on 25 November.
