WORKING PARTY ON TECHNICAL HARMONISATION

12 DECEMBER 2024, THURSDAY, 10.00

Dear Colleagues,

Time has passed very quickly, and we are now approaching the final meeting of the Working Party on Technical Harmonisation under the Hungarian Presidency.

Our meeting will be held on 12 December as a full-day meeting. The morning part will commence at 10:00, followed by the afternoon session at 14:00. The agenda has already been circulated; however, we would like to provide you with a brief overview of what to expect next Thursday.

We are starting the day with the **Safety of Toys** (*particularly important around this most wonderful time of the year*). The purpose of this agenda item is to update Member States on the progress achieved during the 3rd and 4th interinstitutional technical meetings held on 4 and 10 December. Additionally, it will serve to transition the ongoing discussions to the incoming Polish Presidency.

The second agenda item will focus on the **Detergents and Surfactants Proposal**. During our meeting, we will review the work accomplished under the Hungarian Presidency and hand over the file to the incoming Polish Presidency.

The afternoon session will start at 14.00 with the presentation of the Commission on the planned revision of the **Textile Labelling Regulation**. Following the presentation, Member States will be invited to ask questions or make comments.

The Commission will also present their proposal on the targeted, technical amendment of the **Measuring Instruments Directive**. Again, you will have the opportunity to ask questions or offer feedback.

Finally, we will hear from the incoming Polish Presidency, who will outline their plans and priorities for the first half of 2025.

As this meeting marks the final session of Technical Harmonisation under the Hungarian Presidency, we would like to take this opportunity to express our gratitude for the excellent cooperation we have enjoyed throughout the semester.
