#### Introduction

The Belgian Presidency is pleased to invite you to a Public Health Working Party on the Omnibus Directive and European Health Data Space. Please find below a note on the aim of the meeting and the agenda.

# Aim of the meeting

The meeting will start with information from the European Commission on the Omnibus Directive. Afterwards, the Belgian Presidency will open the discussion on European Health Data Space. First, we will give a debrief of ITMs 10 and 11 which took place on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of February. Second, the Belgian Presidency aims to discuss their proposal for an opt-out for primary use and secondary use. Third, Member States will have the possibility to give feedback on preliminary greened or yellowed lines as indicated on the 4CT shared on Delegates Portal. Fourth, and in view of the Coreper meeting of the 14<sup>th</sup> of February, we would like to raise some points that will highly likely be discussed at the political trilogue on the 20<sup>th</sup> of February.

## Agenda of the meeting

#### **OMNIBUS DIRECTIVE**

The European Commission will give a presentation on Article 3 of the proposed Omnibus Directive, which has the general aim to bring down 25% of administrative burden in different legislative files. In the area of Public Health legislation, it wants to amend the Cross-border Healthcare Directive (2011) with a change of reporting requirements in Article 20, paragraph 1. After the presentation, Delegations will be invited to give us their comments on the proposed amendment.

#### EUROPEAN HEALTH DATA SPACE

The Belgian Presidency aims to have an in-depth discussion on several topics by means of a PowerPoint presentation.

### 1) Discussion on the ITMs of 06/02 and 07/02

The Belgian Presidency will give an overview of the course of these ITMs.

### 2) Discussion on the Presidency's proposal: opt-out for primary and secondary use

As in articles 8F (Council) and 7(1a) (EP) for primary use, and articles 35F (Council) and 33(5) (EP) for secondary use.

### 3) Discussion on the green/yellow lines from the 4CT

Delegates will be able to give feedback on preliminary green or yellow lines from the 4CT that will be shared on Delegates Portal this Thursday. Please only indicate the lines that are highly problematic

#### 4) Preparation for the 20/2 political trilogue – Coreper

Please find below the points that will highly likely be discussed at the 20/2 political trilogue.

# • Opt-in genomic data secondary use

As in articles 33(5) (Council) and 33(5a) (EP).

As in article 36A.

## • Intermediation entities

As in articles 35D (Council) and 41(7e) (EP).

# • Assessments of EHR-systems

To discuss the principle of EHR-systems assessments, as well as the European digital test environment at political level.
