**for a new provision in the proposed Resettlement Framework Regulation amending  
Article 19 of the AMIF Regulation (EU) 2021/1147**

*Article 19*

**Resources for resettlement and humanitarian admission**

1. Member States shall receive, in addition to their allocation under point (a) of Article 13(1), an amount of EUR 10 000 for each person admitted through resettlement **under the Union Resettlement and Humanitarian Admission Framework established in accordance with Regulation (EU) XXX/XXX [Resettlement Regulation]**
  2. Member States shall receive, in addition to their allocation under point (a) of Article 13(1), an amount of EUR 6 000 for each person admitted through humanitarian admission **under the Union Resettlement and Humanitarian Admission Framework established in accordance with Regulation (EU) XXX/XXX [Resettlement Regulation] or under a national resettlement scheme.**
  3. The amount referred to in paragraph 2 shall be increased to EUR 8 000 for each person admitted through humanitarian admission **or under a national resettlement scheme** who belongs to one or more of the following vulnerable groups:
    - (a) women and children at risk;
    - (b) unaccompanied minors;
    - (c) persons having medical needs that can be addressed only through humanitarian admission;
    - (d) persons in need of humanitarian admission for legal or physical protection needs, including victims of violence or torture.
