Article 19

Resources for resettlement and humanitarian admission

- 1. Member States shall receive, in addition to their allocation under point (a) of Article 13(1), an amount of EUR 10 000 for each person admitted through resettlement under the Union Resettlement and Humanitarian Admission Framework established in accordance with Regulation (EU) XXX/XXX [Resettlement Regulation]
- 2. Member States shall receive, in addition to their allocation under point (a) of Article 13(1), an amount of EUR 6 000 for each person admitted through humanitarian admission under the Union Resettlement and Humanitarian Admission Framework established in accordance with Regulation (EU) XXX/XXX [Resettlement Regulation] or under a national resettlement scheme.
- 3. The amount referred to in paragraph 2 shall be increased to EUR 8 000 for each person admitted through humanitarian admission **or under a national resettlement scheme** who belongs to one or more of the following vulnerable groups:
 - (a) women and children at risk;
 - (b) unaccompanied minors;
 - (c) persons having medical needs that can be addressed only through humanitarian admission;
 - (d) persons in need of humanitarian admission for legal or physical protection needs, including victims of violence or torture.
