Since we last met at the end of January, we have restarted the technical meetings with the European Parliament (EP) with the aim to clarify and improve, as far as possible, the text of the Directive on consumer credits (CCD) that was provisionally agreed between the institutions in December 2022. We would now like to present how the negotiations have progressed. For this purpose, we would like to welcome you to a meeting of the Working Party on Consumer Protection and Information on 22 March 2023 starting at 10.00.

At the Working Party meeting we will present the work done and explain what has been accomplished during the technical meetings we will have had with the EP by then. If possible, the text will be sent to you in advance, but unfortunately it will probably be just shortly before the meeting. Considering the short time for preparation, we do not expect you to communicate your final view on the amendments in the text at the meeting, but you are of course welcome to share any preliminary or spontaneous views. You will be given ample time to go through the text yourselves before a possible position further ahead would be required.

We very much look forward to seeing you on 22 March and together continue the work on this file!
