The Presidency would like to outline the structure of the meeting on 1 April 2025 (CM 1826/25). Time schedule: Morning session 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. Lunch 1 p.m. – 2.30 p.m. Afternoon session 2.30 p.m. – 6 p.m. The agenda contains three items which will be taken in the order they appear on the agenda.

I. Commission communications "Clean Industrial Deal" and "Action Plan for Affordable Energy" – energy taxation aspects

- Presentation by the Commission
- Exchange of views

The Commission will be invited to make a presentation on the energy taxation aspects of its Communications "The Clean Industrial Deal: A joint roadmap for competitiveness and decarbonisation" (st 6515/25) and "Action Plan for Affordable Energy — Unlocking the true value of our Energy Union to secure affordable, efficient and clean energy for all Europeans" (st 6601/25). Furthermore, the Commission will be invited to elaborate on the energy taxation aspects of its Communications "A Competitiveness Compass for the EU" (st 5785/25) and "A European Steel and Metals Action Plan" (st 7288/25). After that the delegations will be invited to exchange views.

II. Draft Council Directive restructuring the Union framework for the taxation of energy products and electricity (recast)

- Examination of the Presidency compromise text

Delegations will be invited to examine the Presidency compromise text (ST 7234/25 REV 1), focusing on specific topics in the following order:

- 1. Article 4 (indexation), together with the Presidency note on indexation (WK 3782/2025)
- 2. Article 1 (mineralogy and waste out of scope)
- 4. Article 5 (including the definition of single use and changes in this respect in other provisions of the compromise text; implemented acts vs delegated acts)
- 5. Article 16 (exemption for public transport; exemptions for energy-intensive industry; transfer of exemptions from Article 5 proposed in Article 16 paragraphs 5-9)
- 6. Article 24 (State aid)

- 7. Annex II (net calorific values)
- 8. Recitals
- 9. Other changes

III. Any other business

In case delegations would like to raise AOB items, they are welcome to flag them to the Presidency already before the meeting, if possible.
