Paragraph 1

- "Member States shall ensure that…"
- Additional information requirements: ga), n), o), va) etc.

Paragraph 2

- "other distance communication techniques initiated by the trader"
- "before the consumer is bound by the distance contract"



Art. 16(a): information requirements

- Paragraph 3
 - Reminder of RoW (CCD)
- Paragraph 4
 - Readability, colours etc.
 - Paracraph 6a
 - Recital 16
- Full harmonisation



Art. 16(b): right of withdrawal

Similarities

- Personal pension operations
- Time limit for RoW
- Ancillary services


<u>Differences</u>

- Crypo-assets
- Art. 16(b)(6) and (6a) in CGA (lex specialis)



Art. 16(c): payment of the service provided before withdrawal

Paragraph 1 a in CGA: MS option related to insurance contracts





Art. 16(d): adequate explanations

Paragraph 1: general requirements

- "Free of charge" (see art. 8 MCD and art. 5 CCD).
- "...as a minimum include the following elements:"

Paragraph 3: human intervention

- when concluding a distance contract
- in the language used in the pre-contractual information

Paragraph 3a: burden of proof



Art. 16(e): online interfaces

1. CGA deletion

2. Online marketing (the "influencer issue")

3. A warning
