Proposal for a revision of the Package Travel Directive

Dear colleagues,

Based on the first article-by-article examination of the above-mentioned proposal and Member States' comments presented so far, the Presidency notes that in general Member States support the objectives of the proposal, while also pointing out several aspects that need further discussion and clarification.

To facilitate the drafting process, the Presidency provides Member States with a three-column document containing specific **questions** on the **definitions of 'package' and 'linked travel arrangement'** (article 3(2) and (5)), **prepayments** (article 5a), **official travel warnings** (article 12, para 3a) and **insolvency protection** (article 17, para 6).

The Presidency invites Member States to **submit their answers to the questionnaire via the three-column document by 13 May COB**. The answers to these questions will be discussed during the Working Party of 16 May.

The Presidency wants to thank delegations for their efforts and constructive cooperation, and we look forward to seeing you all again on the 16th. In the meantime, please feel free to contact us regarding any queries you might have.
