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**WRITTEN COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS FROM HUNGARY ON THE CONSOLIDATED VERSION (8761/20) OF THE DRAFT
REGULATION ON CMO REGULATION**

Please find below the Hungarian comments to the latest consolidated version of the draft regulation on CMO Regulation (in document number 8761/20 of 11th June 2020).

<u>Article</u>	<u>Comments, explanations</u>	<u>Drafting proposals</u>
Art. 5 (33)	It proposes to amend Annex VIII of the CMO Regulation. The PRES proposal significantly changes the current regulation of acidification and de-acidification. A significant change is, that regardless of the wine-growing zone, the acid content of wines could be increased by 4 g/l. In addition, the acidification and de-acidification has to take place on the same wine-growing zone, which is much more permissive than the current regulation (has to take place on the same holding). We believe that the proposal on the substantial rise of the upper limit of acidification of wine products needs further discussions.
