Note to Antici Foreign Affairs Council 23 June 2025

This note to Antici provides an update on the published provisional agenda for the meeting of the Foreign Affairs Council, which will be held in Brussels on 23 June.

Russian aggression against Ukraine (09:30-12:00)

Ministers will be joined at the beginning by Foreign Minister of Ukraine Andrii Sybiha, in person. Under this point also hybrid threats from Russia will be discussed for which EU INTCEN Director Daniel Markić will provide a briefing to set the scene.

This item will be taken without electronic devices.

China and European Security (12:10-13:40)

At lunch, Ministers will hold a discussion on China and European Security, based on a briefing provided by EU INTCEN Director Daniel Markić.

This item will be taken over lunch among Ministers only and without electronic devices.

Situation in the Middle East and Libya (13:50-16:10)

Ministers will discuss the state of play of hostilities between Iran and Israel, the review of Israel's compliance with Article 2 of the EU-Israel Association Agreement prepared by the office of the EU Special Representative for Human Rights, and the situation in Libya.

This item will be taken in regular format.

Current affairs and Any other Business (16:10-16:25)

Under Current Affairs, the High Representative will refer to the recent negative developments in Georgia. Some Ministers may raise additional issues.
