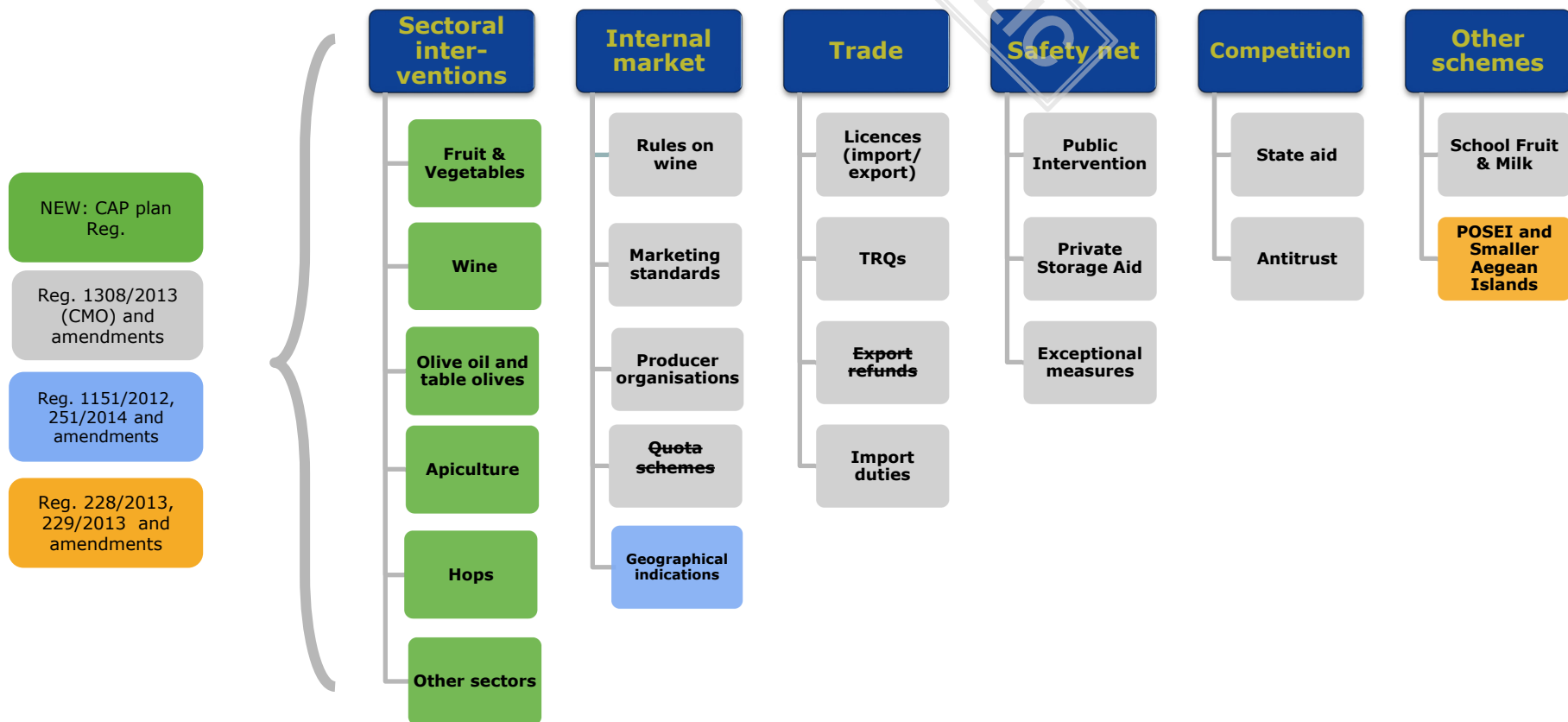

# Post-2020 CAP

- **Future of Food and Farming Communication:**  
**continue**  
**to make GI more attractive to farmers and**  
**consumers and easier to manage**



# Post-2020 CAP: GI needs

- **Wine: legal constraints and inefficient management**  
**(definitions, procedures, scrutiny, protection)**
- **Food: not consistent with Post-2020 and wine DA (definitions, procedures, scrutiny, protection, amendments)**
- **Aromatised wines: 1 scheme for 5 names**

# Post-2020 CAP: means

- Revision of the Wine GI rules (R 1308/2013 CMO).

**Simplification.** Making the scheme more attractive and easy to manage



- Parallel revision of GI rules on food (R 1151/2012) for consistency with Wine



- Incorporation of Aromatised Wines GIs (in R 251/2014).

# Post-2020 CAP: Wine (R1308/2013)

## Simplification

- PDO definition (name, criteria, *vitis vinifera*)
- Objection aligned: MS filter/no notice (agreement already in DA)
- No Committee for registration without objection
- No formal decision for inadmissible objections

# Post-2020 CAP: Wine (R1308/2013)



## Making GIs easier to manage

- Commission scrutiny: IPR focus
- Commission scrutiny: manifest error (already in DA)
- MS Communication on ongoing national procedures
- Cancellation: grounds aligned (+ voluntary)



# Post-2020 CAP: Wine (R1308/2013)

## Making GIs more attractive

- Protection against goods in transit
- Protection in internet



# Post-2020 CAP: Food (R1151/2012)



## Simplification

- PDO definition (criteria)
- Objection aligned: no notice, deadline standardised
- Deletion of the "evidence of origin" in the specification
- No Committee for transitional periods

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## GIs easier to manage and more attractive

- Commission scrutiny: IPR focus and manifest error

# Post-2020 CAP: Aromatised wines (R251/2014)

## Simplification

- Incorporation of Aromatised wines GI in the food Register

Amendment to incorporate aromatised wines

Registrations are not derogations to other Union rules

Existing aromatised wine GIs entered in the Food Register

No committee for transitional periods

Extension of transitional periods for more than 15 years

### **Art. 14a Transitional period for TSG**

Legal basis to grant transitional period in case of registration of Traditional Speciality Guaranteed

## Point 10

### **Art. 49 Application for registration**

MS inform the COM of ongoing national court procedures

### **Art. 50 Commission scrutiny**

IPR focus and manifest error

### **Art. 51 Opposition procedure**

- a) Notice of opposition deleted.
- b) Wording adaptation (no more notices of opposition)
- c) Same deadline for all oppositions.

Wording adaptation (no more notices of opposition)

Deletions to adapt R 251/2014 to the new regime of AW GIs

Deletion of the specific Chapter on aromatised wines GIs



# Changes in details: Article 6

## (Transitional rules for GIs)

### Para 1

#### **Regulations (EU) No 1308/2013 and 1151/2012**

GI rules applying before the entry into force of the CMO Regulation will continue to apply to applications received by the Commission before that entry into force.

### Para 2

#### **Regulation (EU) No 251/2014**

Chapter on aromatised wines GI in Regulation (EU) No 251/2014 will continue to apply to applications received by the Commission before the entry into force of the CMO Regulation.
