Cyber Diplomacy

Presidency Programme

1) A Secure Europe

- Increase democratic resilience through the European Democracy Shield.
- Economic, civilian, and military support to Ukraine.
- Strengthening geopolitical influence by building comprehensive and equal partnerships including Ukraine, Moldova and the Western Balkans.
- Strengthening economic security by improving understanding of specific risks related to critical infrastructure, supply chains, etc. and to reduce such risks.

2) A Competitive and Green Europe

- Strengthening long-term competitiveness by reducing burdens on businesses, citizens and authorities.
- Strengthening the Single Market, encouraging innovation, and developing the Savings and Investment Union.
- Ensuring the green transition. Securing interdependency from Russian energy by increasing the share of renewable energy, including expanding and reinforcing European energy infrastructure and production capacity.

Common Trio Priorities

- 1) A Strong and Secure Europe: Enhancing Cyber Resilience in the EU
- 2) Streamlining Implementation Efforts: Ensuring a more efficient Cyber Ecosystem in the EU
- 3) Stronger Cyber Deterrence: Strengthening our Security and Defence for our Citizens
- 4) Partnerships: Living up to our Values at Global Level while Promoting EU Innovation and Industry
