Transition to a Sustainable Economy

Our main priority will be focused on a **strong recovery** of the European economy, based on a **sustainable and inclusive growth strategy** in the context of the **green and digital transitions**.

Priorities of the Slovenian Presidency in Company Law

- Our Presidency will work towards greater transparency in business and developing sustainable corporate governance;
- We will strive for maximum progress on files while acting as an honest and neutral broker in the interest of all Member States;
- Two legislative proposals:
 - CSRD (Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive),
 - SCG (Sustainable Corporate Governance).

Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD)

- a key proposed instrument aimed at ensuring accessible, comparable and reliable information on sustainability-related aspects of company operations;
- **Planned Working Party meetings:**
 - Today (15. 07. 2021),
 - in September (07. 09., 16. 09 and 24. 09. 2021),
 - 6 meetings between October and December.

Sustainable Corporate Governance (SCG) Initiative

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- Two new legislative proposals expected at the beginning of Autumn;
- Expected to concern directors' duties on the one hand and supply chain due diligence on the other;
- During the Slovenian Presidency we expect introductory presentations and exchanges of views.
